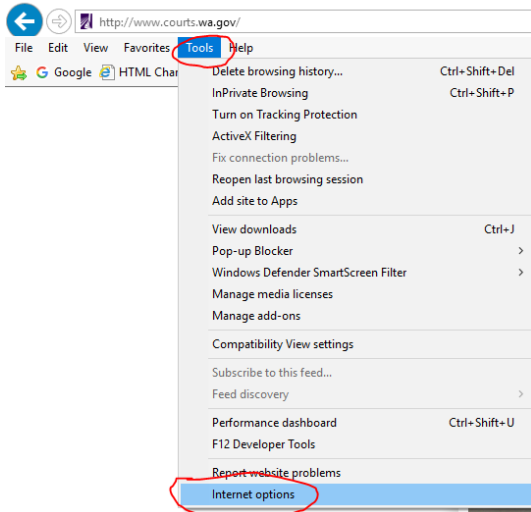


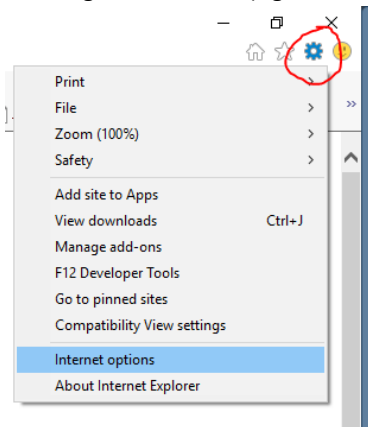
# Setting Cookies in Internet Explorer

From the Tools menu, select Internet Options

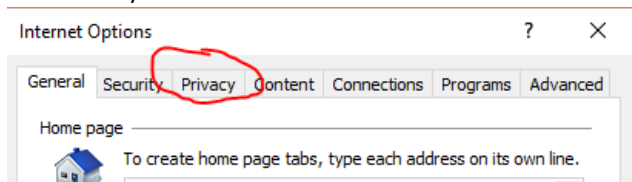
1. Either from your Menu Bar in Internet Explorer



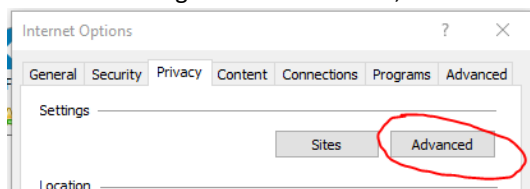
2. Or using the Tool icon (right corner of the browser)



Click Privacy Tab

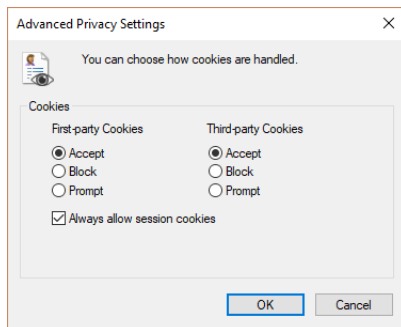


From the Settings section of the tab, click Advanced

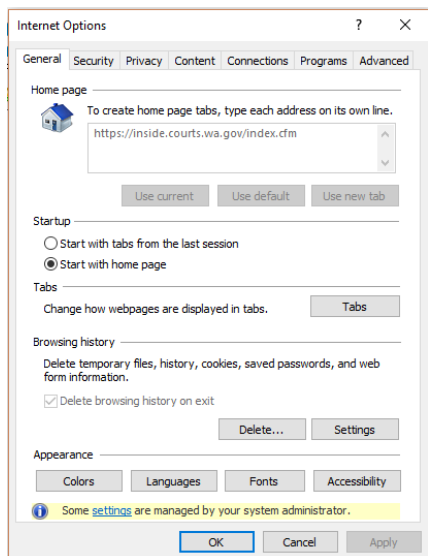


Make sure First-party Cookies and Third-party Cookies are both set to Accept  
Locate and click the checkbox next to Always allow session cookies

Click OK



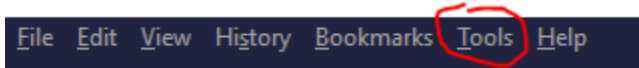

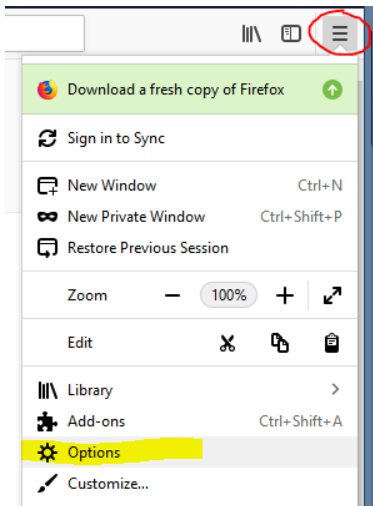
# Setting Cookies in FireFox

From the Tools menu in FireFox

1. Either from your Menu Bar



2. Or using the Open menu option (right corner of the browser)

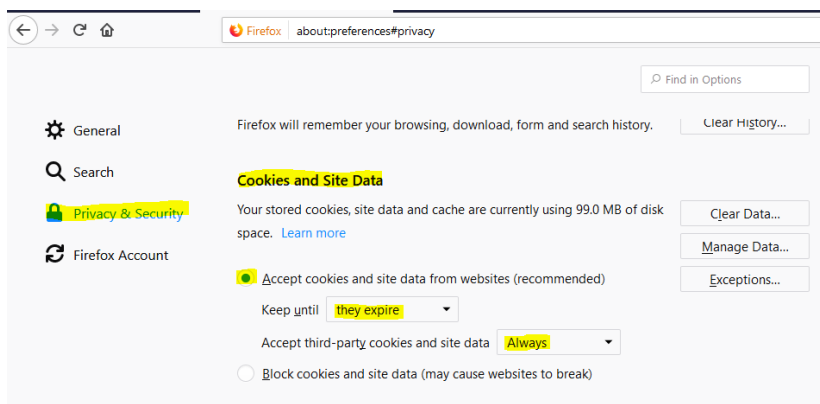


Choose Options, this will open the preferences page

Choose Privacy & Security

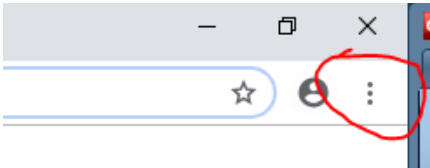
Scroll down to Cookies and Site Data

- Make sure of the following:
  - Accept cookies and site data from websites is **CHECKED**
  - Keep until **“they expire”**
  - Accept third-party cookies and site data **“Always”**

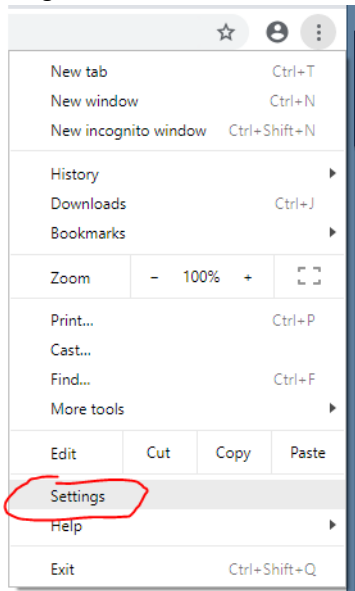


# Setting Cookies in Chrome

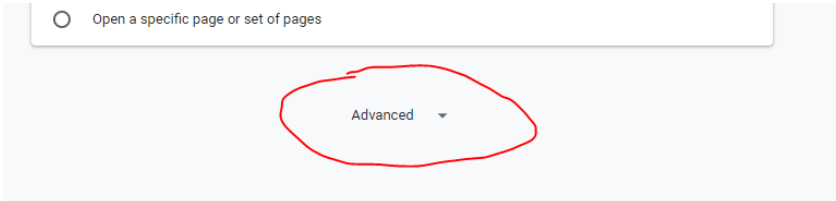
Click the menu icon on the browser toolbar



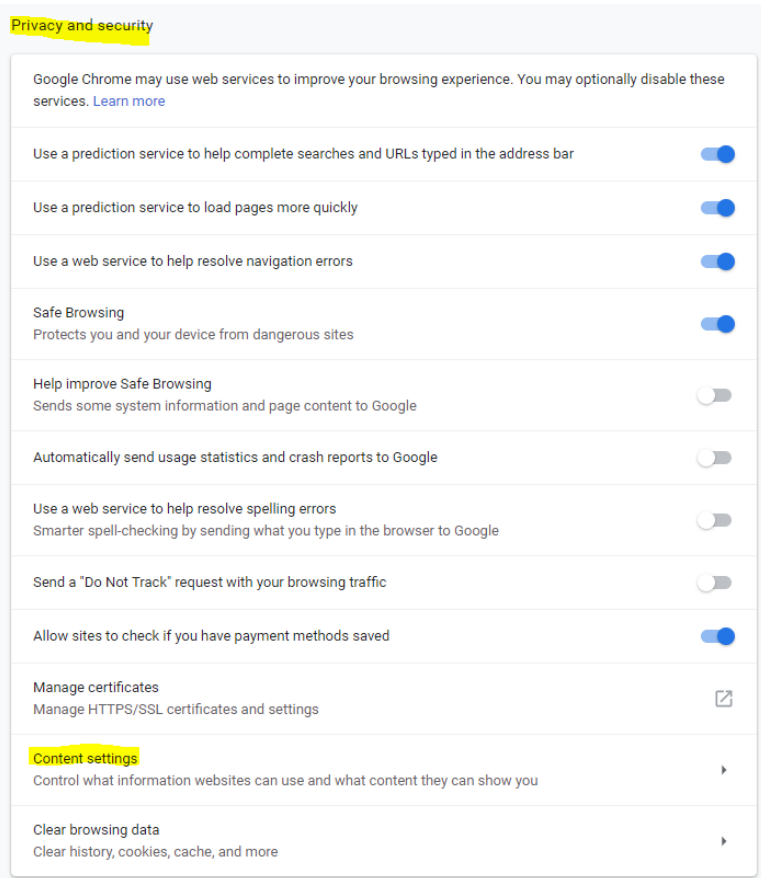
Select Settings



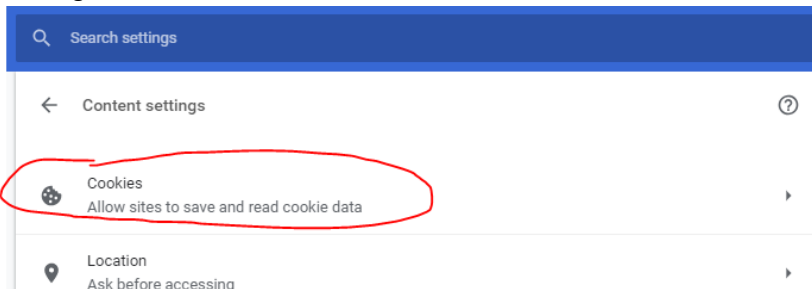
Scroll down to click Advanced



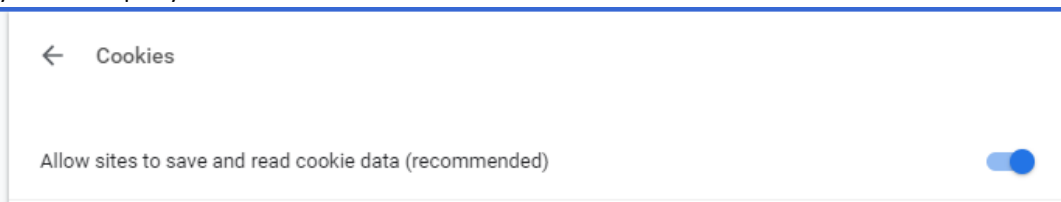
Scroll down to Privacy and security, click arrow to the right of Content settings



Click arrow to right of Cookies



In the "Cookies" section of the dialog that appears, make sure Allow local data to be set is selected to allow both first-party and third-party cookies
